



Dr. Hepner Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship has been dedicated to the memory of Dr. Steve Hepner by his family and friends in co-operation with the JFKS Berlin Alumni e.V. Dr. Steve Hepner, also fondly referred to as “Doc”, was a long-time member of the John F. Kennedy School community as a teacher and Assistant American Principal in the high school. He was the kind of teacher and administrator who knew all of the students. Encouraging creativity and supporting students who might have been stifled by an academic focus, Dr. Hepner often assisted students in finding balance on their way towards graduation. He had a particular keen eye for those who fell under the radar, had great potential but often performed below their ability for a variety of reasons. He was often the supporter of the “underdog” and nurtured relationships with these students to enable them to succeed.

Purpose

The purpose of this scholarship is to further post-secondary education and to honor and reward a student, who has successfully graduated from high school against all odds, by overcoming obstacles which otherwise might have prevented a completion of his/her education. The scholarship money is to be used to support the recipient`s post-secondary education.

Who can apply?

Students of the John F. Kennedy School of each current graduating year (Abitur or High School Diploma students alike) with a 3.0 minimum GPA, who have overcome severe personal and academic problems and successfully graduated from high school.

Amount and duration

The scholarship consists of a onetime payment of
€ 1,000 (one thousand)
which will be awarded in June of each year.



Note: The scholarship money needs to be transferred to the scholarship recipient within the current calendar year, latest in the following calendar year, but only if the recipient can give proof that he/she enrolled at a university. If the recipient does not pick up a post-secondary education by the end of the year following the year of having been awarded the scholarship, the scholarship becomes void and the money will not be paid out. Being a recipient of the Dr. Hepner Scholarship establishes no obligations towards the JFKS Berlin Alumni e.V.

The scholarship money must not be paid back, it is not a credit. It is not a tax relevant or social security relevant income.

A recipient of the Dr. Hepner Scholarship cannot apply again for this scholarship. Applicants which have not been chosen can not re-apply for the scholarship.

Valid application languages are German and English.

Note: Submission of an application does not guarantee an interview. Submitted applications become void, if they are incomplete or have not been handed in on time. In this case applicants will not be invited to an interview.



Accepted applicants will be invited for an individual interview with a two weeks' written notice, and given the information about date, time and location. In case an applicant cannot take part in the interview due to illness, he/she needs to submit a doctor's certificate. In this case a new interview appointment will be made.

An applicant can cancel the interview appointment by providing at least 24 hours' notice. The appointment can be re-scheduled one time.

If an applicant does not show up for the interview appointment, he/she is automatically disqualified.

The personal interview will be conducted with the HS Counselor, a family member of Dr. Steve Hepner, a member of the board of the JFKS Berlin Alumni e.V., the High School coordinators for Abitur and High School Diploma at Haus Reil.

Requirements

Please submit by **4 p.m. on Monday, June 3, 2019** the following items:

1. At least one letter of reference from a teacher who knows you well
2. Your transcript
3. Letter of motivation

Please answer the following questions in your letter of motivation:

- a. Describe a time where you had to make a difficult decision or overcome an obstacle, which might have hindered you to complete your secondary education. Include in your discussion, how you dealt with this situation, who helped you, the outcome and what you ultimately gained.
- b. Describe and discuss a cause about which you are passionate (this can be personal, local, national or international etc.).

We are looking forward to receiving your application.
